

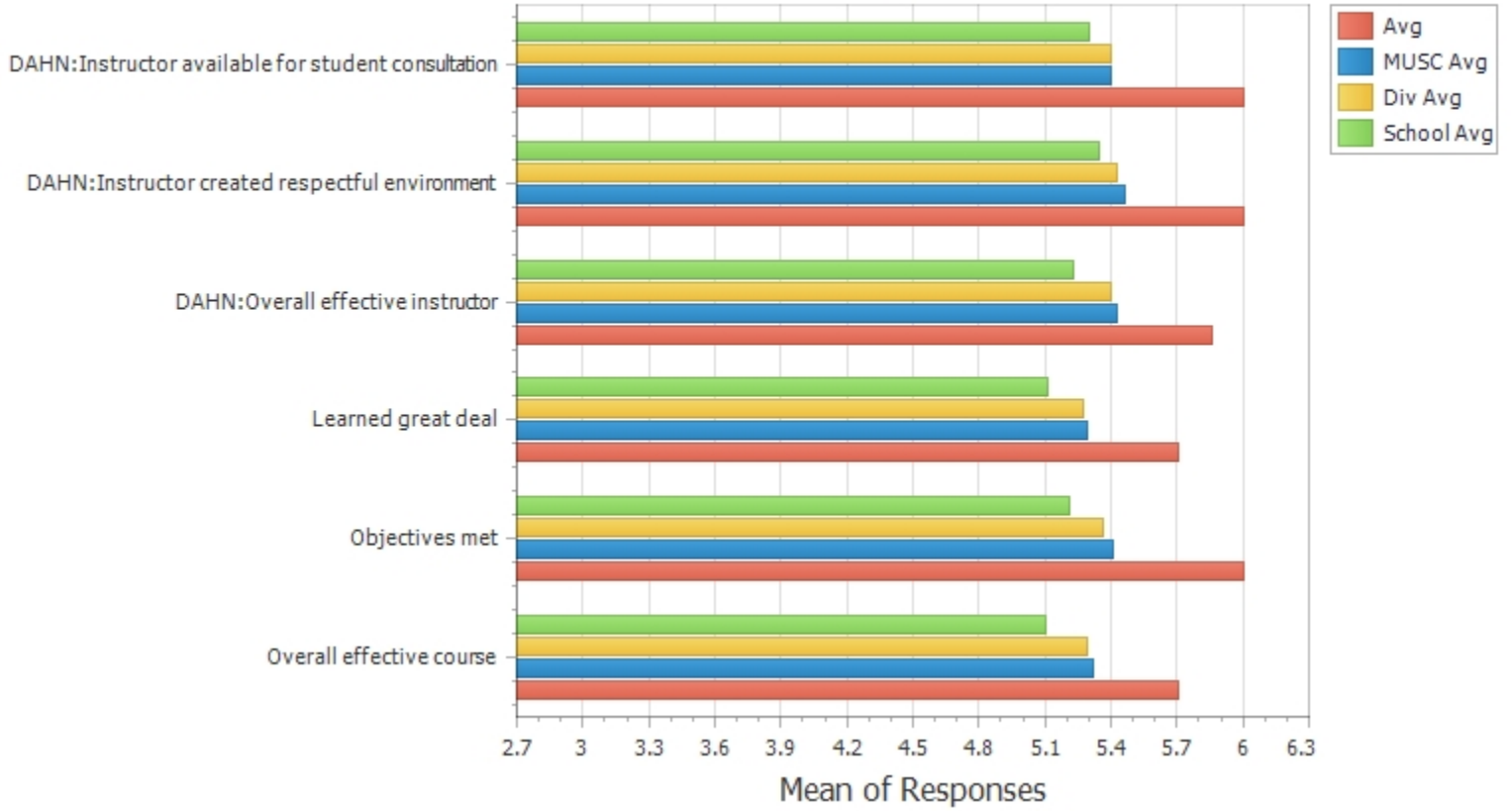

	Aside from a number of mistakes in the textbook and accompanying workbook, it was a very good for the course. The instructor used it to support, clarify, and enhance what he was teaching. 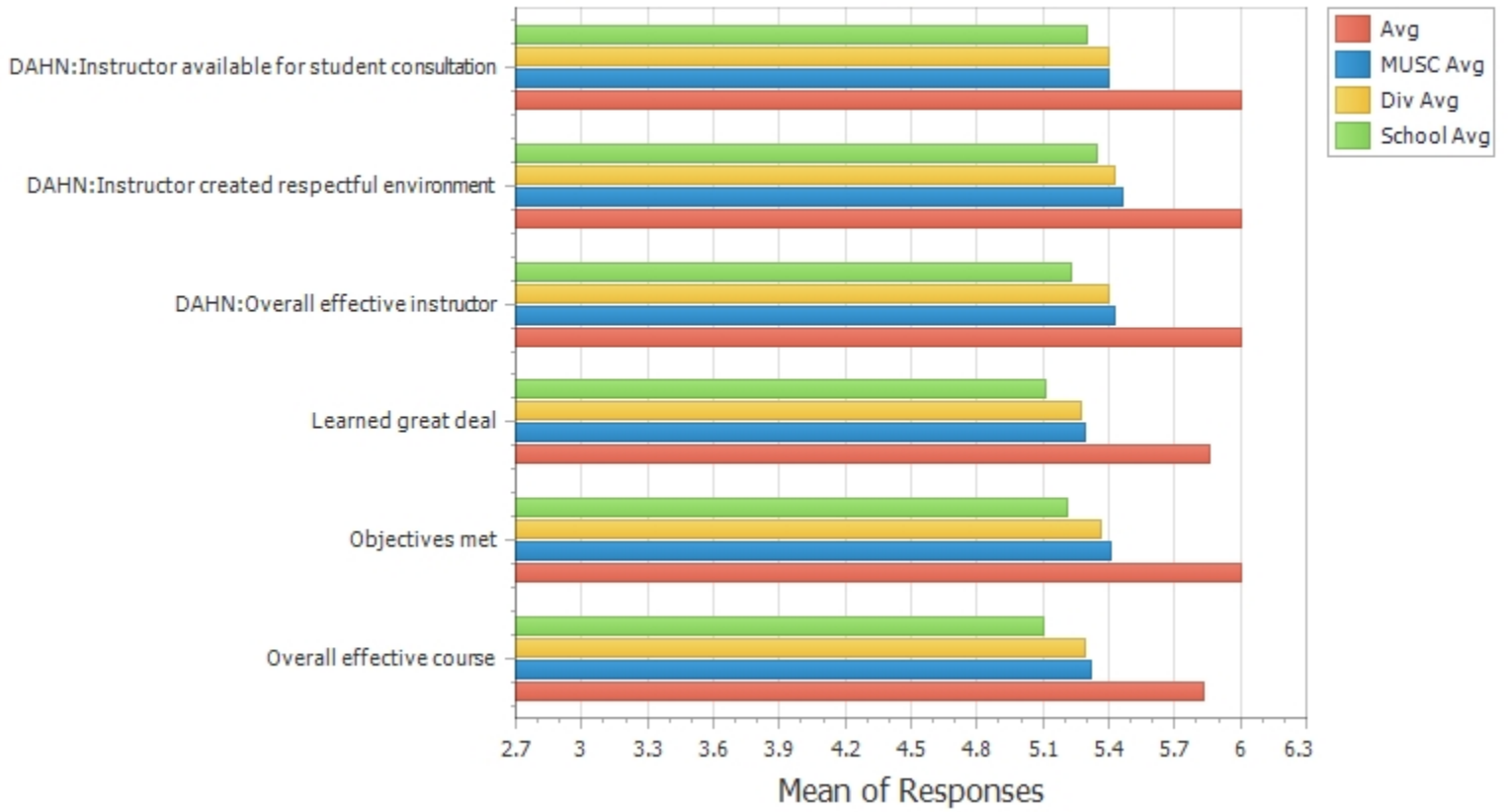

DAHN	The instructor approached composition analytically, and demystified it. He would often ask simply, What parts are especially effective in this composition? The instructor had excellent compositional skills himself, as evidenced by his suggestions, thoughts. The instructor provided time for individual consultations.
